    - **Sun-Sentinel Comment:** The young Lions placed sixth at state in Class 1A, the school's highest finish since a fourth-place finish in 1989 and first time in the top 10 since 1996. That was achieved with a sixth, seventh, and eighth grader combining with a sophomore and junior in the scoring positions, and two eighth-graders completing the top seven. Their average time at state was third-best among Broward teams in all classifications behind St. Thomas Aquinas and Cardinal Gibbons. The Lions won their sixth consecutive district title with a perfect score by taking the top five places. They also won regional and conference titles, as well as their classification

in the Spanish River and Westminster Academy invitationals.
